A counterfeit \$5 bill was passed to the concession stand at the high school on Saturday January 28th during a 7th grade volleyball game. The fake bill was turned over to police for investigation.

A resident reported the loss of a wallet containing credit cards and driver's license among other personal items. The victim was provided a report.

Police were called to the high school, 538 Miller Street on Wednesday February 1st at 3:48 p.m., for underage drinking. A beverage containing an alcoholic beverage was detected by staff who called the police. 3 juveniles were cited for possession/consumption of alcohol and released to a parent.
