A 10 year old Beecher youth was bit in the arm by a dog in the 400 block of Tramore Avenue. The dog was restrained by a chain in a yard and the youth was petting the dog when the bite occurred. The youth was transported to St. James Hospital in Chicago Heights for non-life threatening injuries.
