Police responded to the 700 block of Dixie Highway for a 2 car traffic crash on November 7th at 12:41 p.m. A vehicle traveling north on Dixie Highway ran into the rear of a vehicle turning east onto Fairway Drive. There were no injuries in the crash.

Police responded to the intersection of Church and Fox Hound for a 1 car traffic crash on November 7th at 6:18 p.m. A vehicle traveling eastbound on Church Road turned onto Fox Hound and struck a light pole, knocking the light pole to the ground, before leaving the scene. The 79 year old driver was located at his residence. There were no injuries in the crash and the driver has been referred to the SOS for a license retest.

Police were called to the 1400 block of Rolling Pass on Tuesday, November 7th at 9:32 p.m., for a domestic disturbance. No arrests were made and no one was injured.
